How do I apply? Submit this application with full payment (check or money order) any time before the deadline date. Late applications will not be accepted. Applications without payment will not be accepted, except for international applicants, who may pay by cash, U.S. check, or money order upon arrival. Make checks payable to Bay Zen Center, and please do not include membership dues in sesshin checks. Applications and payment can be hand-delivered to the Zen center (placed in Sesshin Director's mailbox in the office) or mailed to 689 62nd St, Oakland, CA 94609. Write "Sesshin Application" on the envelope.

How do I know if I've been accepted? If you live within driving distance and do not hear from us within three days of the deadline, assume you are accepted. If you live at a distance or are wait-listed, we will notify you immediately.

What if I have to cancel? Please call us as soon as you know. The service fee for cancellations up to two days before sesshin date is \$10; one day before sesshin date is 1/3 the sesshin fee. There are no refunds for no-shows.

When do I arrive? Newcomers arrive at 6 pm for orientation; all other participants arrive no later than 6:30 pm for registration. Sesshin ends at 1 pm. Please do not make arrangements to leave earlier.
